

**Understanding Girls** with Autism or Typical **Development Before** and After Puberty

## **Research Study**



We are seeking females enrolled at 6, 8, 10 and 12 years of age and followed annually over four years.

Participants include girls with confirmed or suspected:

- ASD: autism spectrum disorder
- TD: typical development
- ID: intellectual disability

Participants will come to Vanderbilt University Medical Center for an annual visit which includes a physical, psychological, and social interaction protocol. A diagnostic visit will occur during the first year to confirm or disconfirm ASD, TD or ID eligibility criteria.

## **Potential Benefits:**

- Earn up to \$100 per year (\$400 total)
- Diagnostic confirmation
- Families living 100 miles away or more may be eligible for travel reimbursement
